Introductions:

Members introduced themselves. Welcome to first time member Steven Brown, Deputy State's attorney.

Review Criminal Justice Course Syllabus, level 1 & 2

Members were shown the current curriculum for CJ levels 1 & 2. Concern remains among members that documentation and/or basic report writing is a noted deficiency among new recruits.

Program dual enrollment courses

Courses identified that provided college credit to CJ students. Discussion raised regarding the accuracy/reliability of using WorkKeys scores vs ASVAB assessment for CJ students. Most members leaned towards the ASVAB assessment. It was noted that the Vermont Police Academy no longer requires an entry exam; assessments are specific to each PD., which is why they are looking at the ASVAB. Sheriff Anderson asked about physical training and recommended I review the Texas DPS PT requirements, which is what is used by the Sheriff's Office.
